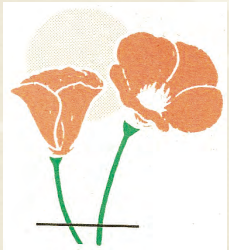


The Peg Taylor Center offers care and support for adults in need and on-going support and education to family members involved in the care of their loved ones.



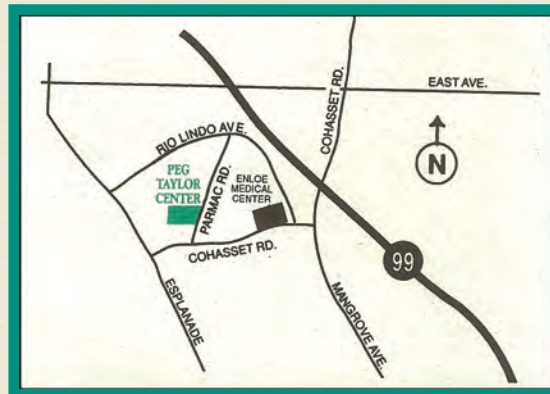
Our symbol - the poppy - was chosen because it is an enduring, beautiful flower, blooming even under difficult conditions.

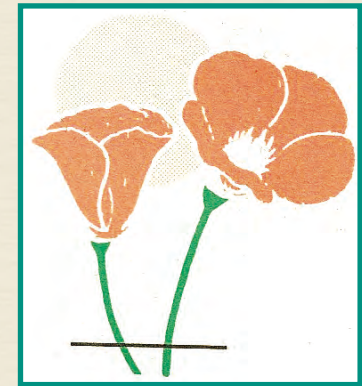
The Peg Taylor Center:

What is Adult Day Health Care?

Adult day health care (ADHC) provides a unique supportive atmosphere for adults ages 18 and over who need help with their daily health care needs or have disabling conditions. At the Peg Taylor Center, our nonprofit program encourages independence and well-being, offering:

- Personalized treatment plan developed by your doctor and our team of health care professionals, with your physician remaining in charge of your overall treatment and care plan;
- Services for adults with disabling conditions and health problems such as strokes, diabetes, respiratory or cardiac illnesses, physical injury, Alzheimer's and Parkinson's Disease;
- Program available from one to five days a week, with schedules set according to the needs of the participants.

• We Offer Personalized Care, Based on Clients' Needs, Including:

- Nursing & Personal Care
- Health Monitoring & Education
- Nutritional Counseling
- Physical, Occupational & Speech Therapies
- Social Work Services

OUR GOAL:

To help older adults with serious health problems, and younger adults with severely disabling conditions, to live at home for as long as possible.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED:

1. Call the Peg Taylor Center OR have a friend, family member or professional call 530-342-2345 between 8:00 AM & 5:00 PM, Monday - Friday.
2. We will arrange an introductory visit at your convenience.
3. We will do a health assessment and work with your physician to develop a personalized plan of care.
4. We will work with you, your insurance, and/or MediCal to set up payment for services.

WHAT IS THE COST?

Adult day health care is covered by MediCal if you are eligible. If not, fees are based on ability to pay.
